The biennial Harding Prize competition is named in honour of Sir Harold Harding, the founder Chairman of the BTS and is open to young engineers aged 33 or under. Entrants must submit an original paper relating to any aspect of tunnelling which they consider of interest to the tunnelling industry, with the winning paper selected by the BTS Committee.

The winner of the Harding Prize receives two tickets to the BTS Annual Dinner, a copy of Sir Harold's book *Tunnelling History and My Own Involvement*, a cheque for £500 and other prizes. Runners up receive a cheque for £100.
